7- BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT (maximum 1000 characters)

MIDAS addresses one of the bottlenecks blocking the full development of an efficient distribution of EU film materials. The visible result of this effort is the search portal www.filmarchives-online.eu that will have been established until October 2006.

MIDAS II will be dedicated to extending the data represented in the system, expanding the consortium and refining the system's search capabilities and multi-lingual functionalities. Broadening the project's base will be crucial for the success of the whole project, since the achievement of its main goals – establishing a central point of reference for retrieving information about moving images in European holdings and fostering standardisation activities on the level of practical application – depends on a critical mass of members and data.

A business model for sustainable operation and further development of MIDAS will be implemented. Special efforts will be made at disseminating the resources available in the system. In total, MIDAS will give access to moving image collection information from 17 institutions in 12 different countries representing 11 languages.

EXEC Summary

In the last 25 years the availability of independent documentary productions to end-consumers has steadily decreased due to the changes in the movie distribution systems. Nowadays the access to documentaries is primarily controlled by the major TV systems not leaving any room to independent filmmakers and producers to find an audience for their films directly. On the other hand more people have become interested in documentaries and want to use them not only for private viewing but especially for educational purposes as well.

OnlineFILM.org will fill this gap by creating a multilingual marketing and publishing platform on the internet for digital documentaries, taking into account global dimensions, national dimensions, languages, legal issues and commerce, providing this service to the general public. We will create a portal for creative documentaries to be downloaded over the internet without high overhead costs, locally approachable via different European languages, connected via multilingual technologies, offering access to films and information on films - anywhere, anytime.

<p>The project D-Platform is aimed at inventing and testing new services for digital theatrical distribution of films.</p> <p><u>Partners</u></p> <p>The project is managed by CN Films that is in charge of the International Digital Film Forum (IDIFF), dedicated to digital cinema. The partners of the projects are independent distributors of a significant size that wish to experiment and seize the opportunities offered by digital.</p> <p><u>Actions</u></p> <p>To answer these problems, we have identified two actions to take within the framework of the project:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Ensure the availability of digitalised European films: this implies the set-up of a significant experimentation of digital releases of films. - Promote European films in a digital context: this requires inventing new services induced by digital technology that could favour the programming of European films and their trans-national circulation.
